THE EIFFEL TOWER OF PARIS

INTRODUCTION

The Eiffel Tower located on the Champ de Mars in Paris, was inaugurated on 31 March 1889. It was the keystone of the Universal Exposition celebrating the hundredth anniversary of the French Revolution. Now the Eiffel Tower has become both a global icon of France and one of the most recognizable structures in the world.

The tower has three levels for visitors. The walk to the first level is over 300 steps, as is the walk from the first to the second level. The third and highest level is accessible only by elevator. The pig iron structure of the Eiffel Tower weighs 7,300 tonnes while the entire structure, including non-metal components, is approximately 10,000 tonnes.

The Tower stands 1,063 ft

[324 m] tall, about the same height as an 81-story building. Upon its completion, it surpassed the Washington Monument to assume the title of tallest man-made structure in the world, a title it held for 41 years, until the Chrysler Building in New York City was built in 1930; however, due to the addition in 1957 of the antenna, the tower is now taller than the Chrysler Building. More than 100 years after the Eiffel Tower was built, its technology, especially the lift and elevator system, remains amazing.
