## SPASSKAYA TOWER OF MOSCOW KREMLIN

### INTRODUCTION

The Moscow Kremlin is the oldest central part of Moscow and is recognized as one of the most beautiful architectural ensembles in the world. It is situated on Borovitsky hill at the left bank of the Moskva River. The area of the Kremlin's plan is irregular triangle and is equal to 27.5 ha.

The Spasskaya Tower, considered by many to be the most beautiful tower of the Kremlin, was built in 1491, and stands on the north-eastern side of the citadel, bordering Red Square. The gate of the Spasskaya Tower has been the official entrance to the Kremlin for centuries. Until the 17th century the tower was known as the Irolovskaya, due to its location not far from the St Irolov church and monastery. In 1658 an Icon of the Saviour was mounted above the gate facing Red Square, and the tower's name was changed to Spasskaya by decree of the Tsar.

The tower is also famous for its chimes. The first clock upon the Spasskaya Tower appeared in the 17th century after the addition of a multi-tiered turret to the top of the tower. Designed by the Englishman Christopher Galloway, the clock boasted gold numerals in Old Slavonic and Arabic upon a blue background decorated with silver stars, but it eventually broke and was replaced in 1707 with Dutch chimes.
